



## 2022 TD Saturday Market Cooking Demo Rules & Regulations

The TD Saturday Market, located on Main Street at McBee Avenue, brings together the finest in-season produce, fresh-cut flowers, gourmet foods, and local handmade crafts every Saturday morning from May through October. Each week the market continues to generate excitement and gain support within the community.

Please note, due to the fluidity of the Covid-19 pandemic, modifications to the information below are possible. We remain committed to evaluate and comply with local, state and federal agencies, while continuously keeping the safety of vendors, staff and the community at the forefront of all decisions.

Cooking demos are held each week in the Lowes Food Front Porch located at McBee Street and Main Street. Cooking demos start at 10:30am and last approximately 30 minutes. It is recommended that chefs provide samples of the finished product to the audience as well as copies of the recipe.

**Application and Selection Process:** Chefs/Restaurants will be selected based upon the quality of the chef/restaurant, location and history with the market. Selections are on a first come first serve rolling basis.

This application does not guarantee you acceptance for a reserved Saturday cooking demo at the TD Saturday Market. You will be contacted to confirm your acceptance. The TD Saturday Market does not compensate for Cooking Demos.

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- Chefs/restaurants must comply with ALL DHEC food safety regulations.
- Cooking demo participants must be entirely self-sufficient. Access to power, a microphone and speaker, a table for samples and a stage with counter space are provided. Chefs must provide all food, means of cooking, fuel, and items needed to perform the demo including tasting dispensers, napkins, silverware etc.
- Priority selection is given to chefs located in the downtown Greenville area.
- Cooking demo participants are not permitted to sell any items. However, you can pass out menus, flyers, etc. advertising your restaurant.
- Vendor Parking: There is plenty of free parking for TD Saturday Market participants near the market site. Pay close attention to the street and parking lot regulations for you may be towed at your risk and expense. All parking must be in a marked parking space outside of the event site. No parking is allowed in any median or lane of traffic (even if the road is closed).
- Per City ordinance, no pets are allowed in the permitted market area – with the exception of service dogs.

- The market reserves the right to refuse participation to vendors who do not comply with market regulations or do not meet Market standards which include, but are not limited to, following all local, city, state, and federal laws and regulations.
- The market is not liable for any injury, theft, or damage to either the buyer or seller, or their property, arising from or pertaining to preparation for or participation in the market.
